

# CLUB MEMBER Guidelines for Conduct

GOAL AND OBJECTIVE:

To define what is expected of Beach Club Members,

their guests and visitors in order to "maintain a level of enjoyment" and a "quality experience" at all times.

## **IMPORTANT NOTICE:**

Beach Club Members are fully accountable for the behavior of their guests - whether accompanied or unaccompanied. Del Mar Management is accountable for the actions of usage guests.

# CONDUCT IS INCLUSIVE, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING:

#### ➤ Noise Abatement:

- 1. No offensive noise at any time.
- 2. The beach club is a "family friendly environment" and welcomes all reasonable activity associated with family fun.
- Family use, and the activity of children, shall not take away from the enjoyment of the beach club for other members or guests.
- 4. Personal audio devices (i.e. IPods) are welcome with ear sets or headsets only.
- 5. There will be no amplified music (outdoors speakers) or outdoor music (live entertainment) after 10pm with the exception of New Year's Eve.
- 6. Authorized fireworks display must conclude by 10pm with the exception of New Year's Eve.

## ➤ Dogs and Pets:

1. Domestic animals are not permitted at the beach club - except those animals assisting handicapped guests.

## ➤ Parking:

- 1. Due to limited space, golf carts are the recommended mode of transportation to and from the beach club.
- 2. During busy periods, parking may be limited to "golf carts only" and all other vehicles may be required to park in the adjacent arroyo.
- 3. Vehicles must be parked in the designated car parking area or as directed by beach club personnel.
- 4. Golf carts must be parked in the designated golf cart parking area or as directed by beach club personnel.
- Motor vehicles and golf carts must not block access to the beach club or inhibit flow of traffic in and around the porte cochere.

## > Smoking:

 Smoking is permitted - in uncovered spaces only - while respecting the wishes of other members and guests in close proximity to you.

#### ➤ Beach Area:

- There are to be no motorized vehicles on the beach, at any time, with the exception of beach cleaning. This includes, but is not limited to: ATV's, cars and golf carts.
- 2. Domestic animals are not permitted on the beach except those animals assisting handicapped guests.
- 3. Due to a strong undertow from time to time, children shall be closely supervised at all times.
- Water sports are available for adults as well as children (who are accompanied by an adult). Please ask for assistance from the Beach Activities Team.
- 5. Beach Club towels, brought to the beach area, must be returned to the beach club premises.
- 6. Beach Club towels need to stay at the beach club please do not take them home.
- 7. There is no space available for personal storage of beach equipment or kayaks.

#### ➤ Pool Area:

- 1. Proper swimming attire is required at all times (i.e. no cut offs, jeans, etc.).
- 2. When returning from the beach, please use the shower to remove sand and salt at all times.
- 3. An adult must accompany children, under the age of 12, at all times.
- 4. Only safety floatation devices are permitted in the pool. Motorized boats and toys are prohibited.
- 5. Only young children and infants are permitted in the children's pool.
- 6. The lap pool is for adult use and for swimming laps only.
- 7. Jumping into pools, and running around the pool area, is not permitted.
- 8. Do not remove beach club towels from the pool area.
- 9. Glass containers are not permitted, around the pool area, at any time.
- 10. Food service is not available on the pool deck area or in the pool.
- Outside food and beverage is not permitted at any time.
- 12. Food and beverage coolers are not permitted at any time.
- 13. Pool hours are from 7AM to 8PM daily with the exception of special events.
- 14. Pool lounge chairs are on a "first come, first serve" basis and are not to be reserved at any time.
- 15. Pool lounge chairs, left unattended for more than one hour, will be made available by beach club personnel for use by other members and guests.

#### ➤ Restaurant:

- 1. Dress code: Resort casual attire (no swim wear, no tank tops, no cut-off jeans, sweat suits ,etc.)
- 2. A maximum of six bottles of wine, in the member wine cellar, per beach club member at any time.
- Other than bottled wine, for storage in the member wine cellar, outside food and beverage is not permitted at the restaurant.
- 4. Restaurant reservations are recommended at all times.
- 5. Restaurant reservations are required during holiday periods and for special events.
- Specific table requests are welcome but not guaranteed.

## ➤ Palapa Bar and Palapa Bar Food service area:

- 1. Dress code: cover-ups and sandals are required when eating at the Palapa Bar or at the Palapa Bar food service area.
- 2. Table seating is provided on a "first come, first serve" basis reservations are not accepted.

## ➤ Fitness Center:

- 1. Proper workout attire is required when using the fitness center.
- 2. Weights and equipment shall be returned to their proper place after use.
- 3. Fitness equipment shall be wiped down and cleaned after use.
- 4. Children, between the ages of 12 and 16, must be accompanied by an adult.
- 5. Children, under the age of 12, are not permitted in the fitness center.
- 6. Please place towels and trash in the bins provided.
- 7. Please limit the use of cardiovascular equipment (i.e. treadmills, etc.) to no more than 30 minutes during busy times.
- 8. Please do not remove items from the fitness center, with the exception of complimentary magazines and promotional materials, at any time.
- Complimentary bottled water is for consumption inside of the fitness center area. Please do not take bottled water out into other areas of the beach club.
- 10. The use of cellular phones, at the Fitness Center, is not permitted.

Beach Club Management reserves the right to address and discourage inappropriate behavior that takes away from the overall enjoyment and Club Ninety Six experience.

Beach Club Management reserves the right to ask members and guests to leave the beach club premises if their conduct is detrimental to the overall enjoyment and Club Ninety Six experience.
